These are the crowns which Frank Dearth of Bond Crown Company sent to me.

As you will notice, the artwork on the Ohio crowns is pretty much the same for each company. This is because the State Emblem is required in the middle of the crown. The Commonwealth Seal of Kentucky can be placed in any position as long as the colors conform with the regulations. These regulations are; the pint crown which is taxed at .575¢ each should be blue, while the quart which is taxed 2.018¢ has to be of the orange design. I believe that this is the information you will need.
